### **4.) MEMBER SPOTLIGHT: CDLA EXPERT DR. ADAM KAYE**

#### Executive Director’s Note:

CDLA Specialist Dr. Adam Kaye will be presenting ***Nuts & Bolts of Marijuana DUI’s*** at our upcoming conference.



I received my Doctor of Pharmacy degree in 1995 from the University of the Pacific. The curriculum mirrored that of a medical school education with courses on pharmacology and toxicology, physiology, clinical assessment, neurology and psychiatry -along with medicinal chemistry, clinical pharmacokinetics and an internship opportunity (a six week rotation) at an in-patient psychiatric facility.

I am licensed as a Pharmacist in Both California and Arizona. I have a board certification in Controlled Substance Management and I have been named a fellow of both the California Pharmacist Association and the American Society of Consultant Pharmacists.

I have been a Professor at the University of the Pacific since 1999. I was employed by Walgreens Pharmacy for 27 years-having retired in 1999 to begin with the California Department of Health Care Services-where I am still employed.

From 2015-2020, I was granted a DEA# and I was employed as a Pharmacist Clinician at ALPINE ORTHOPAEDIC MEDICAL GROUP where I saw patients independently and prescribed medications for the purpose of Pain Management.

This provided me with an additional experience besides my usual pharmacy-based opportunities for monitoring patients. As a prescriber, I was able to evaluate and assess patients for potential medication-related impairment.

My association with CDLA began over 10 years ago when the meetings were still held in Old Sacramento. Over the years, Peter Johnson, Joshua Price, and Mike Donaldson have included me in presentations, cases, and retreats.

I have consulted with attorneys for over 25 years on topics that include polypharmacy, benzodiazepines, opioids, methamphetamine, THC, alcohol, prescription medications, Ambien and many other substances. Cases including DUI, Watson, vehicular manslaughter, assault while under the influence, wrongful death, possession vs intent to sell charge to name a few. I have published a great deal on pharmacology, psychiatric and neurologic medications, along with opioids and benzodiazepines.

It has been my pleasure to assist attorneys between San Diego and Washington State.
