WEBINAR DESCRIPTION:

Many defendants are convicted on the basis of pseudo-science introduced by an expert who is willing to testify to a standard or a scientific methodology that is either not shared by the general community or is not properly applied to the facts of the case. Expert testimony is particularly damaging to a defendant's case and it is made even more damaging when the defendant fails to effectively cross examine the expert. The tide of a criminal trial can change dramatically when the State's expert witness is properly cross examined.

In this one-hour webinar, Ed Barley will address all of the key areas of an alcohol DUI: stop, FST, objective symptoms, PAS, chemical, etc. The cross examination of the government witness requires and understanding of science. The science used is often one sided and designed to convey to the jury your client's guilt. Ed Barley's a recovering prosecution witness who has seen the error of his ways. This presentation provides a glimpse into the minds of the government witnesses.

5.) MEMBER SPOTLIGHT: OKORIE OKOROCHA





Okorie Okorocha joined the California DUI Lawyers Association as a young attorney and was trained in DUI defense to try cases by CDLA members. He went on to try over 80 DUI jury trials in the first chair. His favorite case was one in which he sued the County of Mendocino for illegally euthanizing dogs and cats. He won and the County changed the law. He claims to hold the record for the most lives taken off death row!

Okorie is Board-Certified in Criminal Trial Law and Civil Trial Law, both of which make him a 'Certified Specialist."

Okorie then realized that he was hearing bizarre and incorrect "scientific opinions" from so-called "experts" He had earned a bachelor's degree in Biology prior to law school which meant he had the same or more scientific credentials than 90% of the so-called "experts."

He began his career as a forensic toxicologist in 2010 and went on to earn a master of science in Pharmaceutical Sciences with a specialization in Forensic Science in 2012 and he earned a second Master of Science degree in Forensic Toxicology in 2014.

Okorie worked on the George Floyd civil case and testified in a civil case against former NBA MVP Derrick Rose.

During his career, he has been published in 7 times in the area of DUI forensics. He has also qualified as an expert in forensic toxicology in 50 of the 56 California Counties, 22 of the 50 U.S. states. He has also qualified as an expert in forensic toxicology in Germany and Japan.

Further, his uniqueness lies in the fact that he was never a state criminalist and is not an expert that changes the science when doing defense work after years of false testimony for the government.
