# 5.) MEMBER SPOTLIGHT: RON LOPEZ





As both a licensed private investigator and a registered nurse, **Ron Lopez** uses his expertise as a medical forensics investigator and CA Superior Court-qualified expert witness. With this "toolbox," he is in the unique position to bring sophisticated medical analysis to any investigation or legal defense where it is needed.

While still in high school, Ron completed a research internship in the Dept. of Chemical Physics at Caltech under the tutelage of Dr. Richard March. Dr. Marsh was the crystallographer whose work was foundational to the Nobel-winning work of Linus Pauling. After that, it was straight to Stanford where he completed his Human Biology degree.

Ron's career in the medical world began when in 1981, he took an emergency medical technician course at community college part-time while attending Stanford full time. His one claim to undergraduate fame was being on the field as a band member during the 1982 football game between Cal and Stanford that ended with the now infamous game play involving 15-laterals and a Stanford Band collision called "The Play." While finishing at Stanford, Ron worked part-time as an ambulance EMT in Oakland, CA. Ron's first post-graduation job was as an emergency room & orthopedic technician at San Jose Hospital where he quickly changed plans and decided not to attend

medical school. While working and schooling, he went on to obtain his nursing degree and begin his work in emergency, intensive care, disaster medicine, and mobile ICU.

His career as a nurse has taken him from Butte County where he served as a reserve Sheriff's Deputy and medical officer for the search and rescue team; to Memorial Hospital in Modesto, CA, where he designed and implemented the hospital's first neurosurgical nursing unit; to the Sacramento Fire Dept. where he was recruited to serve as a medical specialist on one of the first national Urban Search & Rescue or "USAR" teams back in 1992. His medical response missions have included the Northridge earthquake, Oklahoma City Bombing; Y2K event; the 9/11 attacks; Hurricane Katrina, and more.

His work in the public health arena included Solano and San Francisco counties where he created innovative clinical quality assurance and disaster response programs. In 2000, Ron transitioned from the FEMA USAR program to the U.S. Dept. of Health & Human Services, National Disaster Medical Service, where he was an on-call federal disaster response nurse. Prior to retiring from federal service, his most recent deployment was for Hurricane Irma.

Ron's extensive medical background includes work as a pharmaceutical research nurse, a biotechnology applications specialist, a mobile ICU ambulance nurse, trauma case manager, neurosurgical unit manager, and as a public health specialist in EMS and Disaster healthcare. Ron has been engaged as a local, regional, and national guest speaker in the areas of nursing, medical forensics, and disaster medicine.

He is also a contributing author in multiple Drunk Driving Defense legal texts on the subject of forensic phlebotomy. He currently keeps sharp with work as an expert witness & medical forensics investigator while working as a part-time medication infusion nurse. Ron is a licensed ham radio operator and enjoys several outdoor hobbies along with his family.
